Volunteer on a Committee

Planning and Land Use Committee

Provide input and direction to local developers and those with building projects in front of the DBI. Attend pertinent city planning and other meetings to offer EVNA's position on relevant matters, educate membership, and weigh in on current and proposed city policies.

Maintain membership roster details, membership status/renewals and other important contact and preferences information. Membership appreciation, anniversaries, recruiting, welcome and orient new members, conduct annual membership drives.

Quality of Life Committee

Collaborate with all stakeholders (police, charities, businesses, CBD, government entities, etc.) to address and improve quality of life issues. Organize/support inter-block communications, crime watch, education on matters of safety, crime reporting, emergency preparedness, etc.


Regular communications to the membership (newsletter), by providing information on relevant issues and expanding on meeting topics as needed. Social media and website strategy design, content and upkeep. Managing outreach and awareness of EVNA activities to non-members, branding, etc.
